TOYOTA SWEDEN LOANS CAR TO EuroRAP FOR RPS DRIVE INSPECTIONS

Toyota Sweden has loaned a Toyota Hiace to EuroRAP to conduct drive inspections of 8,000 kilometres of road in Sweden this year in a unique collaboration between Swedish motoring organisation Motormännens Riksförbund and the Swedish National Road Administration. EuroRAP Chairman John Dawson (below) is seen here presenting the vehicle to Niklas Thorslund of Motormännens Riksförbund. The inspections will be carried out by consultants SWECO Position AB. Other drive inspections over the coming year are planned for Germany and the Netherlands.



A "Road Protection Score" score is calculated by assessing how well the road protects road-users from death and disabling injuries. The data is collected by drive through inspections in specially equipped vehicles which capture video images. From this information, road inspectors assess and score each road's major safety features and hazards.
